In Greece






You have the right to speak and to be heard You have the right to have a guardian appointed to help you You have the right to medical care You have the right to go to school If you are a minor and you want Greece to protect you and to not return you, to your country If you are staying in Greece without your parent(s) If your parents are in another European member state You can apply for asylum at the Asylum Service













If you are recognized as a refugee or a beneficiary of subsidiary protection you are granted a residence permit for 3 years and travel documents, in order to travel abroad

(in EU Member States you can only stay for 3 months every 6 months)

Appeals Authority

If your application for asylum is rejected (or if you are granted subsidiary protection and you believe that you must be granted refugee status) you can appeal the decision before the Appeals Authority They will take a final decision on your claim.

The Greek State is obliged to offer you the services of a lawyer in order to help you appeal this decision. It is your right.

If the lawyer is not provided, ask. The appeal must be submitted within the time frames mentioned at the end of the negative decision.
