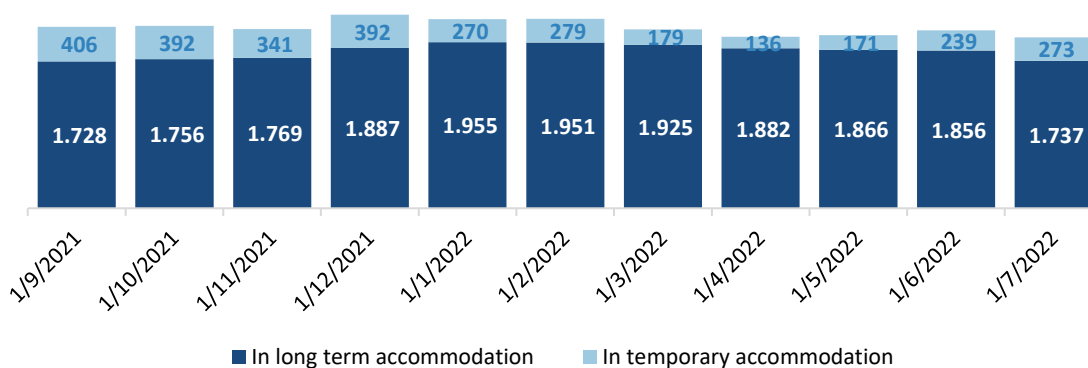

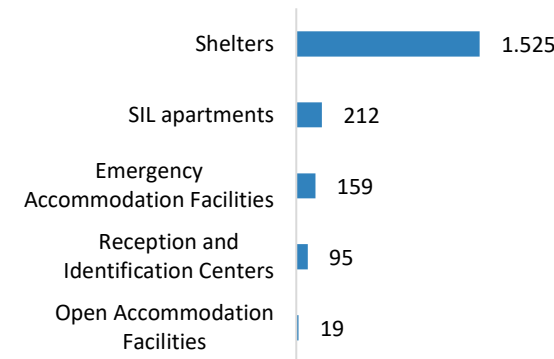

 01 September 2021 - 01 July 2022

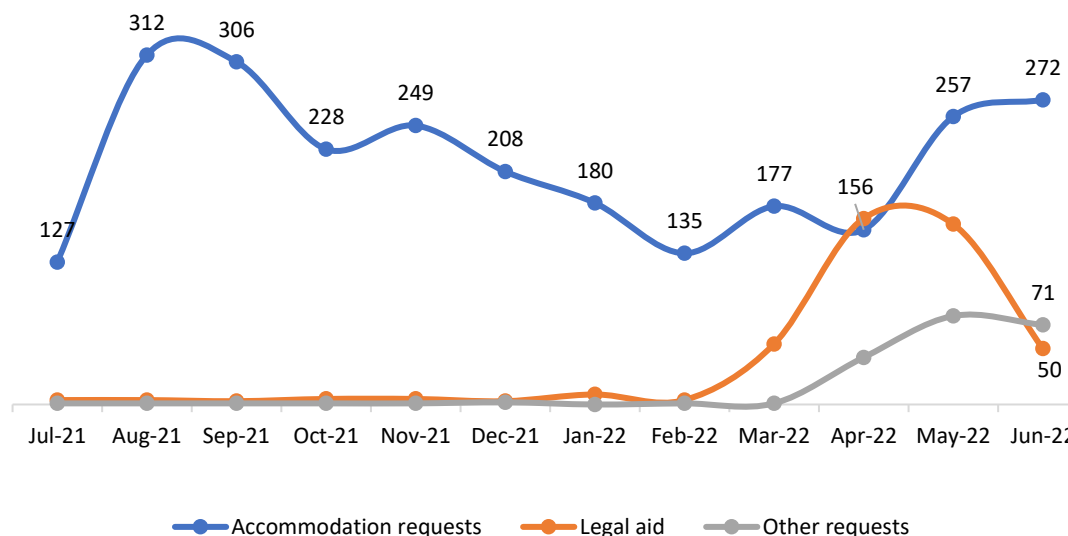


**UAC analysis per accommodation type**

### National Emergency Response Mechanism



*The National Emergency Response Mechanism for Unaccompanied Minors (UAC) in precarious living conditions launched the telephone line in April 2021. Until the end of May 2022, the Mechanism received **5,312** calls, which concern **3,434** different cases of (UACs), out of which **2,754** concern accommodation requests, **475** legal aid, and **205** other requests.*

*Since 02.03.2022, the line has received referrals for **12 unaccompanied\*** and **430 separated minors from Ukraine.***

*\*there are cases of unaccompanied minors whose status changes from unaccompanied to separated following their initial referral.*

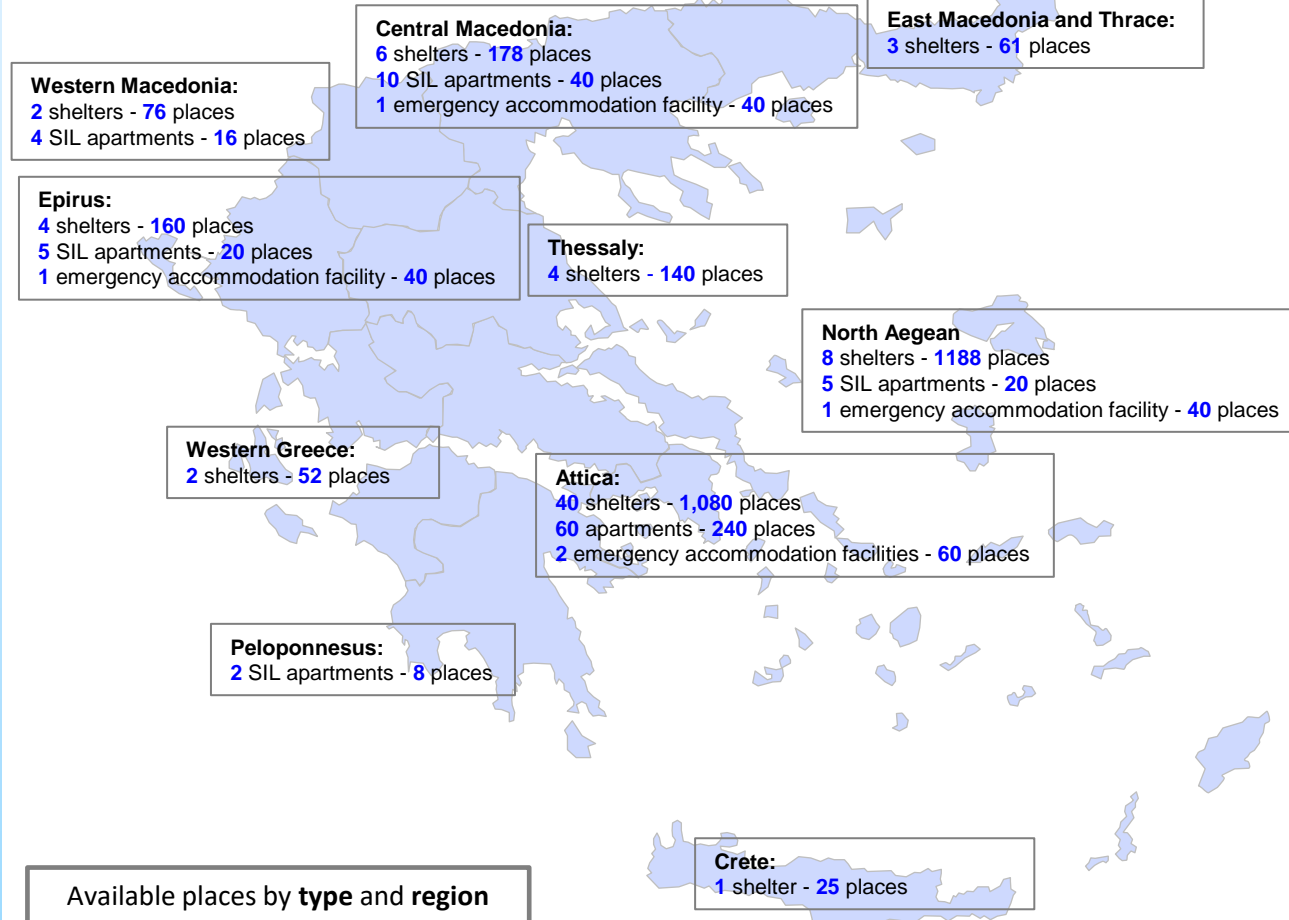

- **Current: 86** SIL apartments for UAC older than 16 years old with total **344** places

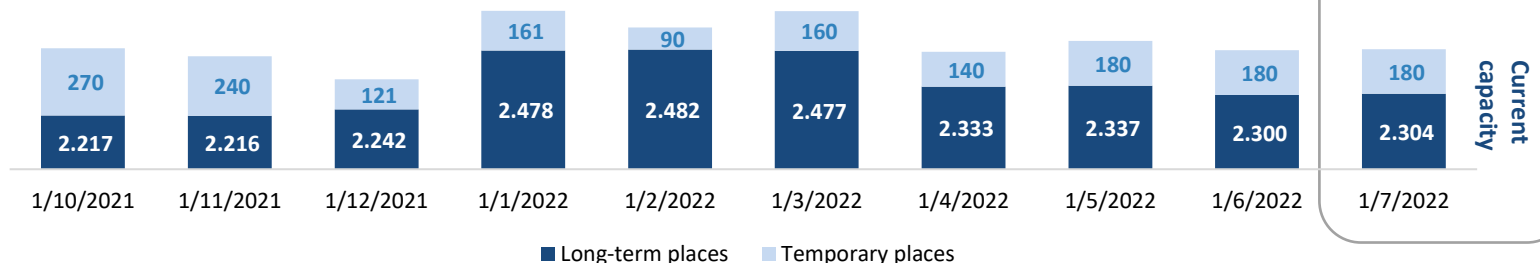
## Emergency accommodation facilities

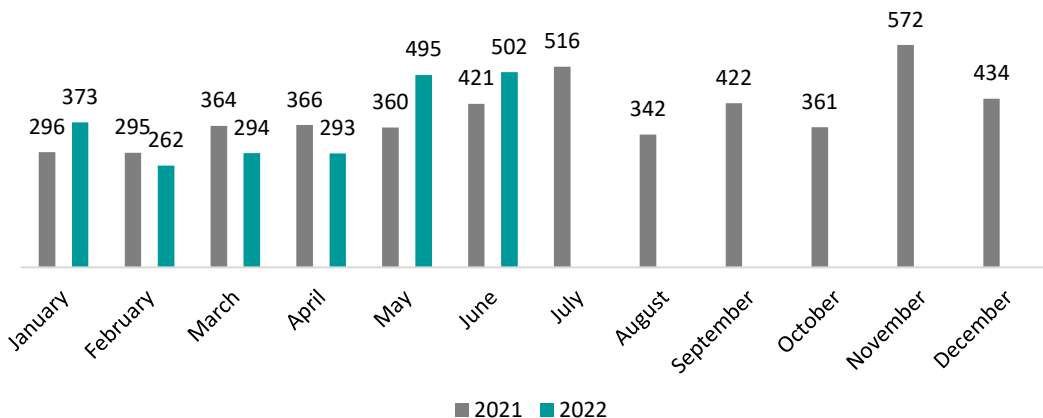

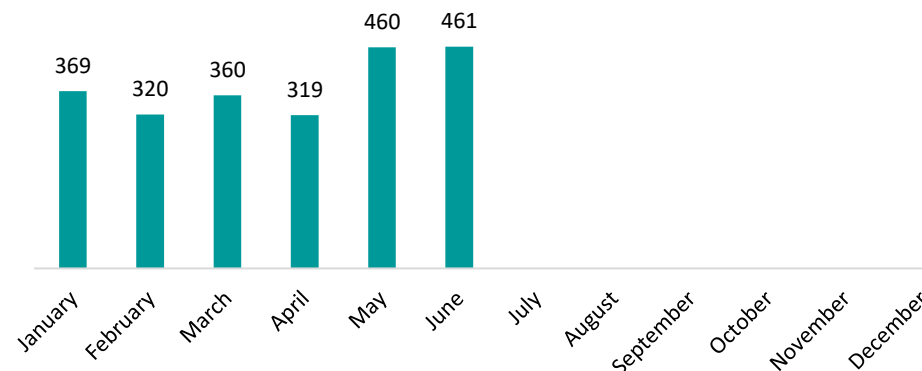

Referrals processed\* per month

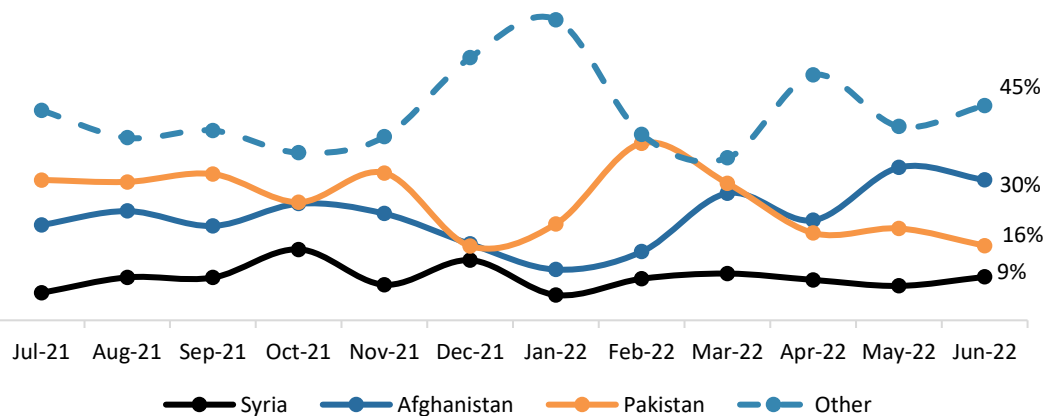

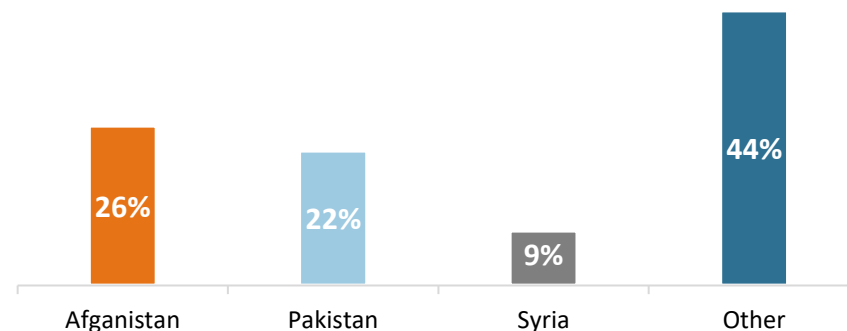
Monthly UAC referrals to EKKA by Nationality
