




**Number of UAC per accommodation type**

### National Emergency Response Mechanism



*The National Emergency Response Mechanism for Unaccompanied Minors (UAC) in precarious living conditions launched the telephone line in April 2021. Until the end of July 2022, the Mechanism received **5,995** calls, which concern **3,724** different cases of (UACs), out of which **2,962** concern accommodation requests, **499** legal aid, and **263** other requests.*

*Since 02.03.2022, the line has received referrals for **12 unaccompanied\*** and **456 separated minors from Ukraine.***

*\*there are cases of unaccompanied minors whose status changes from unaccompanied to separated following their initial referral.*







Referrals processed\* per month




